CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT EXHIBITS

1. Each entry must be the work of a student enrolled in a degree program from a post secondary institution in the state of Mississippi, and the work must be from a class that is taught in the Family and Consumer Sciences/Human Sciences unit of that student's school. All entries must have been completed within the last twelve months to present. Projects not supervised by a FCS/HS faculty member are excluded.
2. Faculty at each institution will assume responsibility for selecting the entries for the exhibition. A faculty signature is required for each student submission.
3. Entries will be exhibited at the Annual Meeting. The student must be present with the exhibit at the designated time on the program, to answer questions in order for the project to be displayed and considered for an award.
4. Each institution will be responsible for bringing the projects to the exhibit area and setting them up at the time designated in the program (8:15-9:00 AM). The only items provided will be a limited number of tables (table size: 53" by 27"). Schools must provide easels, dress forms, table draping and/or any other display materials. Institution must provide cords if electricity is needed.
5. The individual's name, school, and category must be indicated on the back of the project.
6. Each entry must be submitted on the official application form (available at www.msafcs.org). Please keep a copy of your completed forms.
7. The student must be registered for and attend the Annual Meeting (special student registration fee).
8. MAFCS is not responsible for lost, stolen, or removed items.
